

SLIDING FEE SCALE 2022

Annual Income Threshold

This scale is based on patient's family unit size and annual household income compared to the current federal poverty guidelines shown below. Patients are expected to pay either the nominal fee (Class A patients) or a minimum fee (Class B through Class F). The minimum fee varies and you will be billed for the remainder of the total charges for services minus your discount.

Annual Income Threshold

Our sliding fee scale is effective January 3, 2022. This scale is based on patient's family unit size and annual household income compared to the current federal poverty income guidelines shown below. Patients are expected at time of their visit to pay either the nominal fee (Class A patients) or a minimum fee (Class B through Class F). The minimum fee varies and you will be billed for the remainder of the total charges for services minus your discount.
